Stephen was three years old when his father, Thomas, moved the family from Norwich to Windham. He was twenty-two when he married Mary Kingsbery, but they were married less than two years when she died. Stephen married, second, Rebecca Bishop of Lebanon and they had a long life together. They lived in Windham until after 1726 where the births of two children were recorded and Stephen and Rebecca were members of Windham First Church in 1726.¹⁶

On 23 July 1728, Rebecca's father, Thomas Bishop, deeded land in Lebanon CT to Stephen. In the ensuing years Stephen purchased more land in Lebanon and apparently lived there until at least 1748 when he deeded land to his son Eleazar.¹⁴: 4: 105, 110, 145, 206, 488; 6: 27, 205; 7: 162

Stephen and Rebecca transferred membership from Windham First Church to Lebanon First Church 16 Nov 1735.⁷: No. 29: 15
 However, they must have attended church in Lebanon before that for in 1732 Stephen signed a memorial from several men of Lebanon to the Connecticut General Assembly requesting that more roads be built to make it easier to get to church.⁷: 7: 376.

About 1748, Stephen and Rebecca moved to the northeast part of Hebron, Tolland Co in the area that had become the ecclesiastical society of Andover in 1747 and, later, Andover Town. Rebecca died there 8 Feb 1764, age sixty-seven. Stephen lived three more years. He died 23 Mar 1770 age eighty. Both are buried in Andover CT.

Eleazar lived with his parents in Windham until he was about nine years old when the family moved to a farm in Lebanon, New London Co. His maternal grandfather, Thomas Bishop, had deeded the farm to Eleazar's father.¹⁴: 4-110 Although Eleazar grew up a farmer, he suffered from asthma and studied enough medicine to be called a physician.

When he was nineteen and she was twenty, Eleazar married Miriam Phelps of Mansfield CT. If the recorded dates are accurate, the marriage ceremony took place on Eleazar's nineteenth birthday 13 Jul 1738. Between 1740 and 1758, Eleazar and Miriam had eight children. All were born in Lebanon CT, but the Lebanon vital records variously listed their father as Eleazar or William. Lebanon Church records give the baptismal dates of the first six children.⁷: No.19, 105,110, 114, 120, 124, 126 On 8 Mar 1741, Eleazar and Miriam, themselves, joined the First Church of Lebanon.⁷: No.19: 229

In 1748, when Eleazar's father, Stephen, moved from Lebanon to the Andover district of Hebron, Tolland Co, Eleazar bought his farm in Lebanon.®14: 7-162 As the deed records indicate, Eleazar also bought and sold additional land in Lebanon between 1749 and 1765.®14: 8: 225, 10: 459 In April 1752, Eleazar bought the Andover farm of his recently deceased brother-in-law, Aaron Phelps. Phelps's widow, Betty Sprague Phelps, married Abel Jr. (1.2.5.), Eleazar's first cousin. Eleazar sent his aging parents and son, Stephen, to live on the Phelps's farm in Andover. After Eleazar's wife, Miriam, died 13 Dec 1766 age forty-eight, Eleazar sold his Lebanon land to his then two married sons, Stephen and Eleazar Jr., and moved with his five youngest children to Andover to live with his widowed father while son Stephen returned to Lebanon.®14: 11: 172, 36

After moving to Andover, Eleazar married, second, Hannah Dagget. She was twelve to thirteen years younger than he. Their marriage date is unknown, but calculating from her age at death she would have been at least thirty-five when they married. Eleazar and Hannah had no children. Hannah was well educated and served as Andover town librarian for part of her life. Although Eleazar died 28 Mar 1783 age sixty-four, Hannah continued to live in their Andover house until her death 20 Mar 1815 age eighty-three.

Stephen was the oldest of Eleazar and Miriam Phelps Bingham's eight children. He was born at Lebanon CT and baptized 8 Mar 1741 at Lebanon First Church.®127: No. 29: 105 Stephen lived in Lebanon, New London Co until he was twelve years old. He then went to the Andover section of Hebron to live with his grandparents, Stephen and Rebecca Bingham, and to help on their farm. His father, Eleazar, had bought the farm from the estate of Aaron Phelps, Stephen's mother's brother. Stephen worked on the farm for sixteen years. During that time he met and married Sarah Long of Coventry when he was twenty-two and she was about nineteen. Their first three children were born in Andover.

In 1768, Stephen and his family moved to his father's farm in Lebanon while his widower father, Eleazar, and his youngest brothers and sisters moved to the Phelps farm in Andover. Stephen bought the north half of the Lebanon farm and his brother, Eleazar, bought the south half.®14: 11: 172 Stephen and Sarah had three more children while they lived in Lebanon. They transferred their church membership to Lebanon 20 May 1768 and the three children born in Lebanon were baptized there.®77: 235, 152, 156

When the American Revolution began, Stephen enlisted in the CT militia as an ensign in the 1st company, 12th regiment. The regiment was attached to the 9th brigade under Brig. Gen. Eliphalet Dyer and later under Brig. Gen. Saltonstall when it served in the New York area.®63: 188; ®128: 428, 436, 446, 450 Stephen was discharged or resigned from the militia in April, 1777 and moved his family from Lebanon back to Andover. In 1784, the Connecticut military records called him a miller in Hebron and he appeared on the U. S. census for Hebron for the years 1790, 1800, 1810 and 1830.®63

Stephen and Sarah had four more children in Andover making ten children total. All survived to adulthood although two of the seven boys did not marry. Sarah died when her youngest child was ten, she was fifty-six and Stephen was fifty-nine.

Stephen married, second, Jerusha Sprague of Coventry when she was about forty-two years old. They bought a grist mill in Andover in 1805 and operated it for several years until they sold it to Stephen's sons, Harvey and Cyrus.®TAB: Family records and deeds; ®129: 894-5

Stephen and Jerusha lived long lives and died within less than a month of each other. She was eighty-seven; he was ninety-four. The two of them and first wife, Sarah, were buried in the the old cemetery in Andover, Tolland Co CT.®67

Rebecca was the second child of Eleazar and Miriam Phelps Bingham. Born 10 Jan 1743 in Lebanon CT, she was baptized six days later, 16 January, in Lebanon First Church.@7: No. 29: 110 Rebecca grew up on her father's farm in Lebanon and shortly after her twenty first birthday she became a member of First Church 5 Feb 1764.@7: No. 29 The following year, Rebecca married Israel Loomis Jr.@127 She was twenty-two years old. Neither Lebanon nor Norwich vital records give the births of their children.

Eleazar Jr. grew up on his father's farm in Lebanon and at the age of seven became the oldest son at home when his older brother, Stephen, went to Andover to live with their grandparents. At the age of twenty or twenty-one he married Esther Loomis. The Lebanon First Church records give the date as 25 Dec 1766, but a birth date of 28 Feb 1766 was recorded for his first child.@127 The couple lived with Eleazar's parents on their farm for about two years. During that time, his mother died 13 Dec 1766.

In 1768, his widowed father and five youngest children moved to Andover CT. Eleazar Jr. bought the south half of the Lebanon farm and Eleazar's older brother, Stephen, returned from Andover to buy the north half.@14: Vol 11: 360

Eleazar Jr. and Esther had six children before the American Revolution began. The children were born in Lebanon, but their births were not recorded in the Lebanon vital records or in church records.

When the war began, Eleazar enlisted in the militia and was assigned to Major Ebenezer Backus's 4th Connecticut regiment of Light Horse. The regiment was activated 21 Sept to 2 Nov 1776 and aided Washington's troops after the Battle of Long Island.@13: Vol 57 (Jul 1981): 154-6

Eleazar Jr. and Esther had three more children after his term of military duty. The family of four males and five females was enumerated in Mansfield Township, Windham Co in the 1790 U.S. census.@39: 147 Daughter Parthena had already married. By 1800, their jurisdictional area had changed to Tolland Co.@90 In 1810, Eleazar was enumerated under Coventry, Tolland Co.

Esther died in Coventry in 1819 age seventy-one. Eleazar lived another nine years and died 8 Feb 1828 age eighty-two. He did not appear on the 1820 U.S. census.

Sarah, the fifth child of Eleazar and Miriam Phelps spent her childhood in Lebanon, but at the age of fifteen, after her mother died, she moved to the Andover section of Hebron, Tolland Co with her father and her four youngest siblings. Two years later, when she was seventeen, she married her cousin, Whiting Backus, of Windham. He was twenty-one. Their grandparents, Mary Bingham (1.3.) and Stephen Bingham (1.11.) were brother and sister. Whiting's father was John Jr., son of John and Mary Bingham Backus. Sarah and Whiting had four children whose births were recorded in the Windham records.

Aaron, the youngest child of Eleazar and Miriam Phelps Bingham was born in Lebanon CT. His mother died when he was eight years old and his father moved the youngest members of the family to Andover CT shortly thereafter.

When the American Revolution began in 1775, Aaron, at age seventeen, signed up as a private in the militia and was paid for a half days' training. In 1776, he also served in the militia for a short while. Then in 1777, when Col. John Chandler's 8th regiment of the Connecticut Line was formed and federalized, Aaron enlisted at the rank of corporal. He was promoted to sergeant 10 January 1778 and served out his three years being discharged 15 April 1780. He fought in the battles of Germantown and Monmouth. For his service he was paid in depreciated currency.@63; @64: 231 This would later have made him eligible for a certificate for land and may be why he moved to New York State after 1800. For his service, Aaron was awarded a pension under the Pension Act of 1818 and appeared on the New York list as a Connecticut pensioner.@64: 641 @181: S 45,280

After he was discharged in April, 1780, Aaron moved to MA where he again answered the call to arms. On 13 Oct 1780 he served as a private for six days in Fletcher's company, Simond's regiment for the Pawlet alarm.

Aaron married about 1780. By 1790, he and his family lived in Partridgeville Twp, Berkshire Co MA. As indicated on the U.S. census, he had two daughters.@39: 31 By 1800, Aaron and family had moved to South Hero, Franklin Co (Grande Isle Co 1802), VT. The 1800 U.S. census indicted that his first two daughters were born by 1784 and that a son was born between 1784 and 1800.@90: VT: Franklin Co: 78 By 1818, Aaron lived in Plattsburgh, Clinton Co NY with wife, Susannah, and ten year old daughter, Charlotte. His occupation was mason.@181: S 45, 280

Silas Long was a Congregational minister and farmer. He may have graduated from Yale College in 1790 when he was twenty-five. He lived first in Mt Holly, Rutland Co VT and was married to Betsey Root by 1800.@90: 115 They moved to New Haven, Addison Co VT by 1804 when Silas became pastor of the New Haven Congregational Church. He served as pastor for five years, but lived in New Haven the rest of his life.@400: 123: 46; @136: 45; @113: 67; @115: 229; @150: 40 From 1830 to 1832, he was clerk of the same church. He and Betsey had no children, but his second wife, widow Sophia Champlin, had two children. In 1850, her daughter, Sophia, lived with them.@92: 181

Stephen was baptized 13 May 1770 in Lebanon CT where he grew up and married.®127 In 1796, he and his family moved to Oriskany Creek in Whitestown Twp, Oneida Co NY with Jonathan Wales. Their community was called Walesville and they lived there for twenty years.®90: 168A3; ®136: 42 Jonathan Wales's Account Books document Stephen's dealings at the Wales's store 1801-1803.®402 In February, 1818 the family moved to Paris Twp, Portage Co OH and located in the northwest part of Lot 34.®401: 506 They lived in Paris for twenty-seven years.®113: 48C; ®115: 234; ®150: 238 As a widower, Stephen may have gone to Kalamazoo MI in 1845 with his son, Stephen, and died there in 1846. However, his death may also be confused with son Stephen's death in Kalamazoo in 1846.

Harvey lived in Andover all his life and died one year before his father. He was a farmer and ran a grist mill and store with his father and brother, Cyrus. Theodore Alfred was a career army officer and compiler of the 1898 edition of The Bingham Family in the United States. He was commissioned 2nd Lt. in 1879 in the Corps of Engineers after graduating from West Point and promoted through the grades to major. In 1890, he was appointed military attache to the U.S. Embassy in Berlin for two years followed by a similar posting in Rome, 1892-1894. In 1897, he was promoted to colonel and appointed Superintendent of Public Buildings and Grounds in Washington D.C. and Military Aide to President McKinley in charge of official ceremonies at the White House. This appointment continued through the Spanish American War until 1903 when he asked to be transferred to the army engineering district in Buffalo NY. In 1904, he was injured by a falling derrick and lost his left leg above the knee. He was brevetted brigadier general and retired 12 Jul 1904.®116: 1: 218

After recovering, Gen. Bingham became police commissioner in NYC, 1 Jan 1906. A statement he made concerning the relationship between crime and foreign-born Jews aroused a storm of indignation and led to the formation of a democratically organized Jewish community, Kehillah.®404 He resigned in 1909 to be appointed NYC chief engineer for highways and then consulting engineer for bridges until 1915 when he resigned.

During WW I, Gen. Bingham was recalled to active service in 1917 and assigned to supervision of military installations from NY to ME. He returned to retired life in 1919.®210: 1: 36

While in England in 1894, Theodore had studied the Bingham records in Sheffield. Returning to the U.S., he added to his own notes, the notes of William Weaver, Daniel Havens Bingham and Walter F. Bingham and produced the 1898 edition of The Bingham Family in the United States. Although the edition was far from complete, it made the material permanently available and stimulated further research. With the assistance of many others, General Bingham worked on the manuscript of the 1927-1930 edition.

His first job was with Westinghouse in Pittsburgh. He also joined the PA National Guard. He moved to NYC in 1908 and joined the NY National Guard.

In 1911, Rutherford left Westinghouse after passing the foreign service examination and was appointed secretary to the legation at Quito, Ecuador. His postings after that were: Washington D.C. 1913-15; Vienna, 1915-17; Copenhagen, 1917-18; Havana, 1918-19.

He left the foreign service in 1919 and in 1920 joined the Mercantile Bank of the Americas in NY as one of their senior management. In 1921, he moved to Standard Oil Company as a vice president and spent three years working between South America and NYC. In 1925, he lived on a farm in Bucks Co PA.
