**1.7. Nathaniel BINGHAM** (Thomas)

Nathaniel was about twelve years old when his father, Thomas, moved the family from Norwich to Windham. Twelve years later, Nathaniel married Sarah Lobdell. They lived in Lebanon CT for a few years where their first child, Sarah, was born. By 1709, Nathaniel and family lived in Windham where their second child, Isaac, was born. Two years later, Nathaniel's father, Thomas, gave him an 81 acre farm on the east side of Merrick's Brook. The surrounding area was to be set off for Windham's third church in 1732.

In 1731, Nathaniel and son, Isaac, were among the petitioners for the separate church. Nathaniel took an active role in forming the new church and securing its first minister, Ebenezer Devotion. Called the Scotland Church, eighty-nine members transferred from Windham's First Church when it was officially organized in the fall of 1735. On 19 Nov 1735, Nathaniel was chosen one of the first deacons. He was active in church affairs and in 1740 he and several other prominent members built their own pew at the west end of the pulpit next to the stairs. Nathaniel was also involved in major church controversy over the right of churches to ordain their own ministers and the right of laymen to preach. He served as a committee member to select a minister for the Plainfield CT separate church.@8: 454 Nathaniel died age seventy-three. His inventory valued his property at £132.09.06. Sarah, his wife, died age eighty.

Sarah was born 16 Dec 1707 at Lebanon CT, the first child of Nathaniel Bingham and Sarah Lobdell. During most of her childhood, she lived in Windham on her father's farm in the Third or Scotland Church area of the town of Windham. She married Joseph Walden of Windham when she was sixteen. They were married for thirty-one years before he died in 1755. Children are unknown.

Sarah married, second, Col. Thomas Dyer, the husband of her deceased first cousin Lydia Backus, daughter of Mary Bingham (1.3.) and John Backus. She was forty-seven. Dyer's marriage to Sarah was a third marriage for him. As second wife he had married Mehitable Gardner in 1752, but she lived only one year after their marriage.@23: 393

Sarah married, third, Jacob Dresser when she was fifty-nine years old. Her death date is unknown.

Isaac was born in Windham 1 Jul 1709, but grew up on the farm in Scotland which his grandfather, Thomas, had given to his father, Nathaniel about two years after Isaac was born. When he was twenty-three, Isaac married Sarah Backus of Norwich. Of their ten children, the last two were twin girls, the first incidence of twins among the descendants of Thomas Bingham.

Isaac and Sarah did not have a particularly happy time raising their sons, however. Adonijah at age eight and Gamaliel at age six died within months of each other in 1745. Isaac and Sarah's fifth child and fourth son, Silvanus, also died. He served as a soldier in the war against the French and Indians and succumbed when he was twenty or twenty-one years old.

Isaac, with his father, Nathaniel, was among the group of Windham First Church members who petitioned in 1731 for a separate church society for the rapidly growing area of Scotland.@8: 274 Isaac's two oldest children were baptized in the Windham church, but he and his family were formally dismissed on 9 Feb 1735 in order to become part of the new Scotland congregation.@16: 13

Isaac appeared on the 1790 U.S. census for Windham CT with a household consisting of himself and four females, undoubtedly including Sarah his wife, and daughters Eunice and Temperance who did not marry.@39: 153

Isaac died a widower age eighty-eight. Son, Nathaniel, and daughter, Temperance, administered his estate.@3: No. 369

Jeremiah was the fourth and youngest child of Nathaniel. He grew up on the family farm in Scotland and when he was twenty-four years old married Mary Brewster, three years his senior. She had been married to Reuben Lillie, but widowed 28 May 1737 at age twenty-four. Mary was the daughter of Jonathan Brewster and Mary Partridge and traced descent from William Brewster of the Mayflower through Love and Wrestling Brewster.@24:249 Jeremiah's children, all of whom were by Mary Brewster, thus are Mayflower descendants.

Jeremiah and Mary lived within the Scotland Church society. In 1758, Jeremiah was appointed a member of a committee to divide the society into proper school districts.@8: 554

Mary died 9 Aug 1768 age fifty-five. Her youngest child, Huldah, was ten years old. A little over a year later Jeremiah married, second, Mehitable Craft 12 Oct 1769. She was forty, he was fifty-two. They lived together until he died age sixty-eight. Bond was given in Windham Probate Court, but no will survives.@3: No. 373 Jeremiah was buried in Scotland CT.@67 Mehitable lived six more years.

Nathaniel, the oldest child of Isaac and Sarah Backus Bingham was born in the Scotland section of Windham. Although he was baptized in Windham's First Church 24 June 1733, Nathaniel and his parents became part of the newly formed Scotland congregation in 1735. At the age of twenty-three, he married Martha Baker. Their child, Alexander, was born 11 June 1757.

In 1790, Nathaniel appeared on the 1790 U.S. census for Windham with 2 males over 16, one male under 16 and 3 females.@39: 153. He lived next to his father, Isaac. On the 1800 U.S. census for Windham, he was recorded with 3 males and 5 females. Both of these

accountings provide evidence that son, Alexander, and his three children lived with Nathaniel. Further, Nathaniel's will provided the privilege for his granddaughters, Lucy and Sally to live in his house, and he made grandson, John, executor of his estate.

Eunice grew up in the Scotland Church area of Windham. Although little is known of her life, a church record does survive. At the age of seventeen, on 7 Nov 1752, she and six other young women of Scotland church had "liberty to build in the sete behind the front sete in the women's gallery. Provided they build within a year and raise the pue no higher than the sete is on the mens' side. Never ye less," says the chronicle, "ye above said have built said pue higher than ye order and if they do not lower ye same within one month from this time, the society committee shall take said pue away."@8: 553

Eunice did not marry, but lived with her younger sister, Temperance, who also did not marry. Together, they appeared on the 1790 U.S. census for Windham as two females over the age of 45.@39: 75 Eunice died 5 Jan 1816, eighty years of age. Sister, Temperance was her executor and lived until 1828.

Silvanus was the fifth child and fourth son of Isaac and Sarah Backus Bingham. He escaped the disease that killed his two older brothers when they were six and seven and he was only four, and grew to manhood in the Scotland Church sector of Windham CT.

When a young man of nineteen, the war against the French and Indians was well under way and Silvanus enlisted in Col. Fitch's company, Connecticut provincial regiment. He must have seen action for he was recorded as being in His Majesty's Hospital at Albany between June 13 and Oct 31, 1760. Later, beginning 19 Mar 1762, Silvanus was on the payroll of Capt. Durkee's third company, Gen. Phineas Lyman's 1st regiment, as sergeant, but on 19 November, 1762 he was recorded, dead. Thus, at age twenty-one, he was the third son of Isaac to die. His oldest brother, Nathaniel, was the only one left to carry on the line.

Temperance was the seventh child and third daughter of Isaac and Sarah Backus Bingham. However, by the time she was born two brothers and a sister had already died, thus Temperance was the fourth child to survive. She lived in the Scotland Church area of Windham and apparently remained at home as an adult, unmarried. After her parents were both dead, she and her unmarried sister, Eunice, lived together.@90: 75 Temperance outlived her sister by sixteen years, but died at nearly the same age. She was eighty-two.

Naomi and Ruth, the last two children of Isaac and Sarah Backus Bingham were twins. They were born in Scotland 16 Aug 1751 and remained there until they were in their mid thirties. Naomi married first when she was thirty-five and moved to the Columbia section of Lebanon CT. She and Joseph Hill had three children. Naomi was sixty-two when she died 11 March 1814.

Ruth, Naomi's twin sister, also married in her mid-thirties a man named Joseph and had three children. On 12 Dec 1787, at the age of thirty-six, and exactly one year after Naomi's marriage, Ruth married Joseph Loomis. Ruth and Joseph Loomis's three children were born just one year after each of Naomi's. Ruth lived until 1825, ten or eleven years longer than Naomi.

Jeremiah Jr. was the first son and fourth child of Jeremiah and Mary Brewster Bingham. He was born and grew up in the Scotland section of Windham CT. At the age of twenty-two, Jeremiah married Esther Palmer, daughter of a separatist minister.

During the American Revolution, Jeremiah served four terms, was credited with nine months service, and received a pension under the law of 1832. His first term was for two months beginning 1 February 1776 and he was sent to Cambridge and Roxbury MA. His second term was for a month and a half. He entered from Windham, but served at Providence RI in Capt. Jonathan Rudd's company, Col. Brown's regiment. His third term was for four months. He joined the company at New London 1 August 1777 and was appointed sergeant 12 September. His fourth term was for two months from August to October 1779 when he served around Groton CT.®64: 657; ®181: 12, 211

Jeremiah and his family were enumerated on the 1790 U.S. census for Windham living close to brother, Uriah, and sister, Mary, and her husband, Asa White.®39: 153 Esther, Jeremiah's wife, lived to be seventy-eight years old. Jeremiah lived to age eighty-six.

Uriah, the fifth child of Jeremiah and Mary Brewster Bingham was born 10 Nov 1751 at Scotland, Windham Co CT. When he was twenty-three he served in the Lexington alarm at the outbreak of the American Revolution.®64: 26 His only other recorded military service consisted of guarding gun powder in 1778.®63

On 26 April 1781, Uriah, then twenty-nine years old, married Eunice Webb. Their first child was born 26 May 1782. They had four more children, but the youngest died when he was twenty-one months old.®67

Uriah and his family were enumerated on the U.S. census for Windham, Windham Co in 1790, 1800 and 1810.®39: 153; ®90: 710; ®136: 583 In 1815, when he was sixty-four, he sold his farm in Scotland and bought the Canterbury homestead and farm where his descendants still resided in 1995.®FESB In 1817, on 4 December, Uriah died age sixty-six, and was buried in the Old Scotland Cemetery.®67 His wife, Eunice, lived to be seventy-three and died 5 March 1830.

Both Gamaliel and Betsey were born in Windham and both were twenty-five years old when they married. The second child and only surviving son of Jeremiah Jr., Gamaliel and family lived in Windham's Scotland Church area.®113: 596; ®115: 45; ®150: 267 Gamaliel was not particularly active in town affairs, but he did serve as surveyor in the year 1807. His reported valuation of £30: 48 placed his family in the lower middle class of Windham.®327: 220

Although Gamaliel did not die until 1860 when he was eighty-four, he was not listed as head of household in 1850. His wife, Betsey predeceased him by two years.
