(from M. Joyce Miller, written by: Muriel Munger Rumann Mielke) In the spring of 1882 Melvin Munger left Natural Bridge, NY with his two eldest children Clarence 7 and Bertha 5 to go to South Dakota. Here, he was to homestead in Harding County, a short distance from Erwin, SD. His brother Duane had been in South Dakota several years. He was a great help to Melvin.

Melvin built a small claim shanty and then sent for his wife and small daughter, Clara Belle. By the time Melvin had his house built and his family moved to SD, he had just 2 cents left. He was proud of this two cent piece and kept it all his life, because as he said "I'm never broke." The Two Cent Piece is now in the safe keeping of a great-granddaughter, Joyce Miller.

The first years were very hard. Grandpa had to walk three miles to his brother's homestead to grind corn in a small coffee mill., so that they would have corn bread to eat. Corn bread, pork and sauerkraut was their livelihood for the first winter.

Water had to be hauled in barrels with an ox team for both brothers. March grass was twisted for fuel. I was told that Grandpa could twist it tighter than most people. That made it burn longer. Grandmother was a sister to Duane's wife Lottie. Grandmother must have had plenty to keep her busy. She knit mittens and stockings for the family. She also made all of the clothing by hand. Two more children were added to the family, Freddie, who died at the age of seven, and Floyd. I never heard Grandmother complain of hardship in her later years. They stayed on the homestead until 1895. Grandfather sold his homestead to Nick Hoffman, a neighbor.

They then bought a place in Erwin. Sometime in 1900 they moved to Boulder, CO. Their daughter, Clara, was there because of her health. She was living with her cousins, Sam and Hattie Greenwood. Clara persuaded them to move to Boulder because the weather was milder.

Grandfather bought a place and remodeled it. It had running water in the kitchen and in the bathroom. The water was piped from thirty miles up in the mountains. Grandfather said to Grandmother, "There now Addie, that is the closest I can come to having a spring in the corner of your kitchen." She had said during the years that they had had to haul their water, "When they build my house, I am going to build it where I have a spring in the corner of my kitchen.

(from Lottie Munger McGarvie Carpenter) In 1900 O. V. Munger with his bride Nora came to De Smet. O. V. operated the "Leader" barber shop until his death in 1923. He was active in social and political affairs. Nora was very active in social and civic affairs until her death in 1957. She probably belonged to every organization at that time. She was a practical nurse and in great demand. She and Mrs. McVey started the Mother-Daughter banquet for Senior girls in 1922. She was one of the first presidents of the De Smet PTA.

O. V. and Nora raised a family of three boys and four girls, who all graduated from high school except who had to carry on in the barber shop after his father's illness and death. Fay also followed their footsteps in the barber trade.

Helen Marguerite's report: "Arthur James and Violet Mae lived near Lake Preston, SD for the firs #t six or seven years of their marriage. Arthur was a farmer. he also practiced veterinary medicine, which he learned from his father, Duane Munger. They had four children born in this area: Merlin, Chester, Vivian and Dorothy.

"In 1907 they homesteaded in the western part of South Dakota, had their house and bard built and moved there in 1908. Here they settled down and raised their family, yes, what a family - - eight more children. They raised all types of farm animals, also farmed wheat, corn, oats, barley, and of course a very large vegetable garden. Lots of potatoes and beans. The work was very hard, the hours long and the children learned at very young age what their responsibilities were.

"All the girls, along with our mother, could perform most any task on the farm. They could milk cows, drive a team of horses, use most all of the farm equipment as well as most men. All except one, that was me, I never could milk a cow with any accuracy and was scared of most animals. About the only animal I could handle was the horse. I could ride horseback, if the horse was gentle.

Water was a scarcity on the farm. We had to haul water from different places and none were very close by. The washing was done on a rub board: guess we all took our turn at doing this job as we grew up. Mother was a good cook, and could make a tasty meal out of nothing. She made most of the clothes for the girls and did a lot of sewing by hand. I Don't know where she found the time along with all the other daily chores that had to be done. The neighbors called on her many times to help in childbirth, sickness and in death. She also sang at some of the funerals as the ones that had passed on had requested.

" In 1919 our barn burned to the ground along with the granary and chicken coop. We also lost a team of horses and a big stack of hay. In the fall of 1922, our house burned and most everything in it went along with winter's supply of canned food., which was stored in the cellar below the house. At that time there were seven kids in school and three not old enough to go. We were all farmed out to different neighbors. A log house that had been vacated sometime before, was donated to us. The neighbors all got together and disassembled and then reassembled it on our place near where the house use to be. This house was about 40 ft. by 25 ft., had three

rooms upstairs and two down.

"Furniture was not plentiful, really not much room for it. In the front room there was one large table with homemade benches, a buffet, and a stand we kept the phonograph on. Sometimes there were chairs, they always seemed to get broken and many times we just used apple boxes. In the winter we had a pot belly stove. The kitchen consisted of a cook stove, cupboard, a work table and the cream separator. Our coats were hung on nails in the kitchen, along with our stocking cap, mittens and scarf tucked into the sleeve.

"Upstairs we had two beds in the girls' room, two in the boys' room, and one in my parents' room. Since we only had one pair of shoes and one change of clothes, there was no other furniture, but maybe a box, trunk or old suitcase.

"This log house was really quite the house. I think the roof leaked from the day it was put on until we all left home. Every fall the ceiling in the upstairs and downstairs was plastered and when the first rain came in the spring, the plaster started falling. We started dodging falling plaster for the next six months; by fall it was ready for another plaster job. I never could figure out why my Dad wouldn't fix the roof: always said he was going to, but never did. I guess when it don't rain it don't leak and you can't fix it when it is raining.

" I really don't know too much about the childhood of the older brothers and sisters as they had left home at a very young age. I do know they

all worked hard on the farm and took care of the young ones. The youngest was four and a half years younger than I was, so there were no babies for me to care for. Also, we really had more liberties than the older ones did. We did have fun playing with the neighborhood kids when we weren't working. We enjoyed the barn dances in the summer time and later at the club house where thay had dances and other special events.

"The 4th of July and Old Settlers Picnic were our two special summer outings. We would leave early in the morning after chores were done and spend the day and stay for the dance in the evening. Rgis was the only time the cows didn't get milked at night.

"To get to school, we walked 2-1/2 miles. It was a one room school house, first through eighth grade. My five older brothers and sisters walked the same distance to a sod school house. we hated to see summer co me, as we always had to pull cockle-burs out of the corn field, about fifty acres, and work in the garden along with all the regular other chores.

" In 1936. I was going home with my father when he lost control of the car and I got out and walked home. It was about a mile, the snow was two feet deep and the temperature was 28 below. I kept falling down in the snow: in doing so lost my shoe and didn't realize then this happened. I walked 3/4 of a mile without one shoe on. My left foot was badly frozen. My toes had to be amputated along with the removal of the skin from the bottom of my foot. This was truly a traumatic event and a turning point in my life.
