Epenetus and Caroline, according to the census, were born in the state of New York. They moved to Wisconsin sometime before July of 1845. In an Empire Prairie, KS news booklet at the St. Joseph public library, dated 1885 it says: "Mr. E. P. Munger and family of Empire Prairie are moving to Belleville, KS. Richard traveled with them and then came back to Empire Prairie.

In a 1879 census L. G. Munger and John Wheatly ran the city greenhouses on Francis St. in St. Joseph, MO; The Buchanan Co. census of 1880 lists La Grants wife Mary 35 yrs. born in WI. La Grant left Empire Prairie and came to St. Joseph. MO to run a bakery with his children and brother. Before he died in 1917, LaGrant came to Wathena, KS to live near his son Turb.

Celia Ann Vaux was previously married to Miles Redfield in Burnett, WI. He died in Wisconsin on Aug. 16, 1867. Their children (Nellie Bell Redfiend 1863-1890 and Ada Ann Redfield 1865-1881) were living with Frank and Celia. Frank was in the Union army 3 years. He ran a livery stable and the "New Nickel" Hotel in

Belleville, KS. He was a penitentiary guard in Lansing, KS and then was a sheriff in Belleville, KS.

Lived in Watheha, KS. , then St. Joseph MO and then to Wathena, KS. They were fruit and vegetable farmers. They would cut ice from the Missouri river like the Mungers in Belleville. They also raised all of the standard farm animals. This was around 1901-1904. They lived there until Turb died in 1929. Juanita Munger writes, "Turb must have run into hard times so he started making wine and whiskey during prohibition. Aunt Edna told of all the Wathena people that came to their house to eat and drink (including the Law Men). She told of one time the "law men" came and ate and drank their fill, and when it was time to leave told Turb he would have to come to jail with them for bootlegging. Turb's son Elmer volunteered to go in his place, and the law allowed it.
